



## SUPPLY LIST (GR. 7-12)

- 5 Binders (one for ELA, one for MATH) preferably zipper
  - \*A 2 inch binder is best with dividers
- Reinforced loose leaf
- 1 Duo tang (ELA – Grade 7 & 8 only)
- 1 Coil bound notebook for ELA 7 through 12
- Pens (MUST HAVE) - red and blue or black
- Pencils preferably HB
- Erasers, Ruler (with millimeters), Pencil crayons, Scissors, Markers
- Glue sticks (3)
- Highlighters (preferably 3-5 different colors)
- Scientific Calculator (Gr. 7-9)
  - \*The calculator should have a  $\sqrt{\quad}$  button and the sin/cos/tan functions
- Geometry Set – all students
- Graphing calculator (Gr. 10 – 12 students)
  - \*Texas Instrument 83 (T183 plus or T184) \*Grade 11 and 12 math
  - \*It is recommended that students in Pre-Calculus 20 or 30 or Foundations 20 or 30 have a graphing calculator
- Dictionary (optional – available at the school), Thesaurus (optional)
- Change of clothes and towel for Physical Ed.
- Runners - non marking soles
- Safety glasses for PAA/PE (Avail. at Princess Auto for \$2.00)
- Mouth Guard – can be purchased for \$2.00 at Olympian Sports
- Warm clothes for outside – bunny hug, sweats, wind suit, socks and hat
